The aim of this course is to deliver quality training to students with various levels of intellectual and cognitive impairment and is designed to empower and support a wide range of adult and teenage learners at the most fundamental literacy level. With a student centered approach, the training students undertake not only assists in developing literacy and job ready skills; it also supports students in developing maximum independence in the community.

MODE OF STUDY

This is undertaken as a combination of class based delivery, excursions and independent learning tasks.

PRE REQUISITES:

Entry to the Course in Initial Adult Literacy and Numeracy is restricted to post compulsory school age learners with evidence of a permanent cognitive impairment/intellectual disability which may be accompanied by additional conditions. Permanent cognitive impairment/intellectual disability must be evidenced which may include formal assessment by a registered medical practitioner, doctors/ specialist reports, attendance at a Special School/SDS, integration support at school or integration support at school with modified curriculum.

PRE-TRAINING REVIEW:

All candidates are expected to complete a Pre-Training Review prior to enrolment. This review ensures that the delivery and assessment plan is designed to meet your individual needs. This will be assessed by a trainer to ascertain your suitability for this qualification. Your eligibility and pathway
